PLANNING YOUR VOLUNTEER DAY: HOW TO USE THIS SCHEDULE

WHERE DID THE ESTIMATES COME FROM?

The above numbers are estimations of the total number of volunteers needed to complete each construction stage at 53 Temple Ave. Habitat Newburgh volunteers will be helping on the house, but the Thrivent Builds Homes grant requires that 50% of all volunteers must be Lutheran and 25% of Lutheran volunteers must be Thrivent members. We have had great success in surpassing these required percentages as we have begun clean up work on site. Let's keep it up, volunteers!

There are two figures for the project goals. The first, "Total Project Goal," relates directly to the requirements to construct the house, while the second, "Total Hours," describes the total number of volunteers that will eventually build the house, from the pre-build tasks to the dedication.

CONSTRUCTION SITE VOLUNTEERING

Please use this sheet as reference for planning your volunteer days to site. If you and your group have special interests and skill sets, call the Habitat office to begin scheduling your group and/or individuals. And please remember, your congregation's certified professional electricians, plumbers, and/or heating specialists interested in contributing to this Thrivent Builds project are welcome to contact the Habitat office about getting involved on these tasks for the build. All construction volunteers must be 16 years or older to work on site. The Habitat office can work with youth under 16 to organize special work projects related to site.
